## 4) Love Without Boundaries Shunyi Outreach Foster Program.

## 5) NHF Special Care Units, Jiaozuo, Luoyang and Xin Yang, Henan Province: ( 75 beds)

These units provide humane and loving, hospice care for infants and young children with severe congenital defects who are unlikely to survive under normal circumstances. Those who survive are unexpected blessings.

**Jiaozuo** ; **Faith, John and Riley** were admitted this month. Faith and Riley passed away shortly after admission.

To date 147 children have been admitted to this unit

**Luoyang** **Arden , Gerald, Katie and Morgen** were admitted this month. **Willow, Stacy, Arden and Morgen** passed away peacefully. To date 200 children have been admitted to this unit.

**Xin Yang** **Angel, Alice, Claire, Haidee and Lailah** were admitted this month. **Angel, Alice and Lailah** did not make it. To date 59 children have been admitted to this unit

## 6) Love Without Boundaries Heartbridge Rehabilitation Unit(18 beds)

**HJ Ni** has been returned to her orphanage. **L G Qiu** was admitted to Beijing United hospital twice in respiratory distress. She still has issues with her heart that need to be resolved.

Our Home in Beijing needs a new coat of paint on the inside. The building was last painted about 7 years ago and is now looking somewhat worn.
