3) NHF Special Care Units, Jiaozuo, Luoyang and Xin Yang, Henan Province:

These units provide humane and loving, hospice care for infants and young children with severe congenital defects who are unlikely to survive under normal circumstances. Those who survive are unexpected blessings.

Luoyang (Maria's Big House of Hope,) Belle and Peter passed away peacefully..They had several birth defects. Lynlee also went home to be with her Maker, She died peacefully, loved and cared for. Leo was transferred from Jiaozuo to Luoyang for surgery to repair his hernia and he is doing well so far.

Jiaozuo: Daniel and Jimmy were admitted and will require surgery. Miguel a premature baby aged 3 days was barely alive when he was admitted to our unit. He survived only 2 hours.

Xinyang (Alexandra Yeo and Open Arms Children's Foundation Unit) Gerald was admitted in a grave condition after bowel surgery of unknown condition. He passed away peacefully 6 days later.
